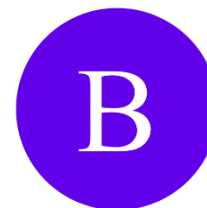

Thank you to the **John Ben Snow Foundation** and **Barney II Foundation** who partnered together to donate over \$19,000 to EWA!

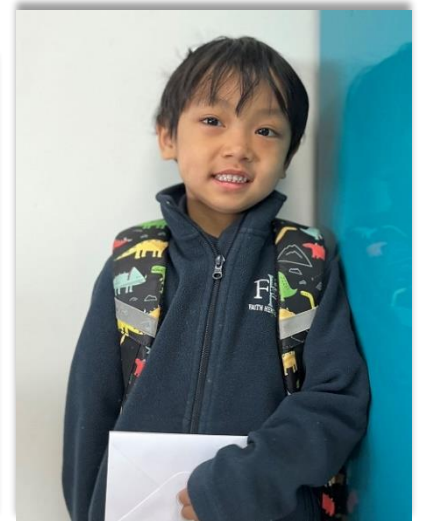


What Will Set You Apart?

Career Conversations

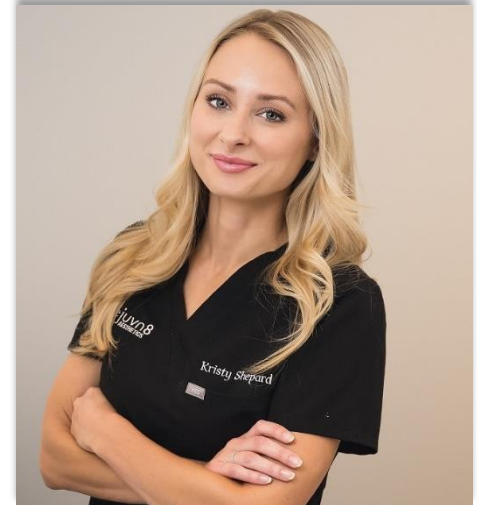
