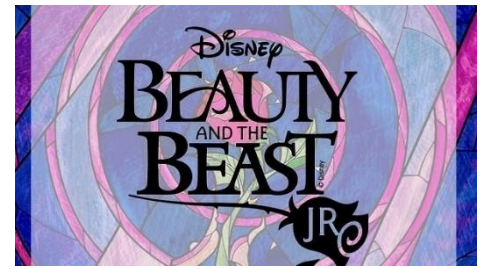
## In Memory of...
