Scripture Spotlight

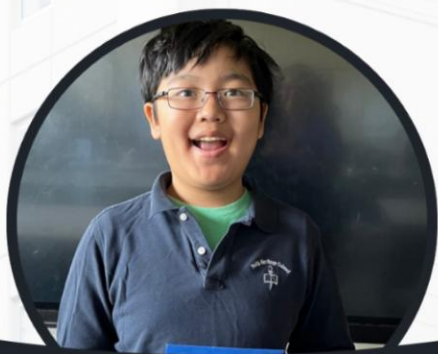
“A person's heart plans his way, but the Lord determines his steps.” – Proverbs 16:9
